## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

### BOSWORTH ROAD, BULL IN OAK, CADEBY

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order at the above location.

On the 11th and 12th June 2020 temporary traffic signals will be in use between 09:00 and 15:00. On 13<sup>th</sup> June 2020 there will be a one day road closure on Bosworth Road, Bull in Oak, Cadeby from the junction with Ashby Road (A447) for 280m.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will be implemented for public safety for **Premier Road Surfacing Ltd** to undertake the construction of a new entrance and resurfacing work for a new development.

The proposed alternative diversion route will be via: Ashby Road (A447), Hinckley Road (A447), Rectory Lane, Main Street, Cadeby Lane, Cadeby; The Park, Market Bosworth and vice versa.
